NOTE: Although we will be at the Lions Club Park in Eagle River, we will set up on the football field and adjacent areas rather than in the ball park as in past years. There are many details the committee is working out regarding this location such as potential layout, acquisition of electricity and water, fencing, and more. Details will be provided in our confirmation letter in which each vendor will receive a map, vendor identification ribbons (limit 4) and one vendor parking sign two weeks prior to the games date.

Vendor spaces are limited, and will be assigned on a first come/first serve basis with the aforementioned considerations applied. If an application is not accepted for any reason, the vendor fee will be promptly returned. Once an application to vend has been accepted, the fee is **NON-REFUNDABLE**.
